A few words from the Ward Sergeant:



Catalytic converters:

In the early hours of 23rd March Ward officers, as part of taskforce involving over 300 officers across the Met, conducted raids on groups of individuals involved in catalytic converter thefts.



- To protect your converter from theft, ask your vehicle dealership if they can give you any advice on locks or guards that are approved by the vehicle manufacturer.
- Alternatively, try to make sure your vehicle is parked in a garage overnight, or if you have a commercial vehicle park it in a secure compound. If this isn't possible, park in an area that is well-lit and overlooked and try to park so that the converter can't be easily reached by potential thieves. Vehicles that sit high above the road are particularly vulnerable.
- You should also register your converter and mark it with a forensic marker, which will make it harder for thieves to dispose of. Visit: <https://www.securedbydesign.com/> for more details.
