PRIORITIES

Violence against the Person - We have had 16 reports on **Violence Against the person (11 common Assault 5 ABH including incident on the bus in the two months)** from the month of March to April. The majority of incidents involving violence against the person are committed by people known to each, investigations were carried out. Some of these assaults are committed by school children and have or are being dealt with. We have increased our visibility patrol around school closing hours where possible.

Drugs – These relate to possession of cannabis, the offences are being or have been dealt according to police policy. We will continue to show our visibility both foot and mobile patrol in the area. We will continue to work with residence where information is provided to concentrate our patrols in a more needed areas.

Vehicle crime - We have had incidents regarding vehicle crime (**3Theft of a motor vehicle and 7 Theft from a motor vehicle over two months**) Suspects have been going around using keyless entry device to steal cars, stealing items and number plates from and off cars. We have increased our visibility patrol where possible in these areas.

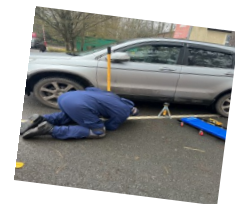
HOW TO KEEP YOUR VEHICLE SAFE
