Here is the latest edition of the Old Coulsdon update. Safer Neighbourhood Team would like to give you an updates about crime and policing information for the month of July. We have worked along with other ward teams attending events, including Old Coulsdon village fair, school funfair and catalytic converter making. PRIORITIES

Violence against the Person: We had low report of Violence against the person cases reported in July. (1 Common Assault, 2 ABH and 1GBH) The majority of these incidents were committed in private premises between people known to each other. We will continue to increase our visibility patrol and reassurance visits where possible.

Drugs, We have had one drug case reported in the month of July (**possession of cannabis**) while officers were on mobile Patrol, Officers approached suspects smoking cannabis in the car, the drugs were seized and the suspects have been issued Penalty Notice for Disorder. We will continue to work with residents where information is provided to concentrate our visibility patrols both on foot and mobile in a more needed areas.

Vehicle Crime: we have had a slight increase in vehicle crime reported to the Safer Neighbourhood Team in this month (3 Theft of a Motor Vehicle and 2 Theft from a motor vehicle) the latter where suspects gained entry using keyless device to people's cars to steal valuable items or cars. An investigation has been conducted with support and evidence provided by victims. We continue to work with residents where information is provided to concentrate our patrols in targeted areas.




