PRIORITIES

Violence against the Person: There was a slight increase on Violence against the person cases reported to in June. (four Common Assaults four ABH and one GBH) The majority of these incidents were committed in private between people known to each other and the investigation were carried out and were dealt with by other Police units. We will continue to increase our visibility patrol where possible .

Drugs: There is one current ongoing investigation relating to drugs.

Vehicle offence: There have been two reports this month on Vehicle Crime. One of these was a Theft from a Motor Vehicle where the suspect has gained entry to cars to steal valuable items and number plates. An investigation has been conducted with support and evidence provided by victims. We continue to work with residents where information is provided to concentrate our patrols in targeted areas. Please to take precautions when leaving your motor unattended such as removing all valuable items, locking your vehicle, security screws to your number plates if you have a stick on number plates.
