Safer Neighbourhood Team will like to give an update of crime and policing for the month of August. We have worked with other ward teams to conduct a speed Gun operations on Coulsdon Road and Marlpit Lane and have worked as a cluster in plain clothes to target **Burglary** and **Motor Vehicle Crime.** We continue to do our best to work with partners and residents for intelligence lead policing to build **More Trust, Less Crime and High standard.** Below are the ward focus priorities reports.

PRIORITIES

Violence against the Person: We had low reports of Violence Against the Person Cases reported to us in August(2 GBH and 3 ABH) The majority of these incidents were committed in private premises between people known to each other. We will continue to increase our visibility patrols and reassurance visits where possible.

Drugs: We had 1 **possession of Cannabis** case reported to us in this month. Officer's on patrol discovered 2 persons sitting inside a car in a remote area, upon approaching to speak with them, officers smelt cannabis. One admitted to be in possession of cannabis, the drugs were seized, crime prevention leaflets were given and Community resolution order were issued to those involved. We will continue to work with residents where information is provided to concentrate our visibility patrols both on foot and mobile in a more needed areas.

Vehicle Crime: We had 0 reports of vehicle crime in the month of August. The team have worked together on plain clothes to patrol in all wards including Old Coulsdon, Coulsdon Town, Kenley, Purley and Woodcote to Target **Vehicle Crime** and **Burglary**. We continue to work with residents where information is provided to concentrate our patrols in targeted areas


