PRIORITIES

Violence against the Person: There were 13 Violence Against the person reports in October. These were for 7 reports for common assault, 5 for ABH and 1 GBH. The majority of these incidents were committed in private premises between known parties, two committed by school children and one is a neighbour dispute. Some of these reports are still being investigated. We will continue to increase our visibility patrols and reassurance visits where possible.

Drugs: There is 1 report on a potential class B drugs importation to an address in old Coulsdon for October. This was intercepted at the airport and investigation is ongoing

Vehicle Crime: There were 4 reports of vehicle crime in the month of October 2 theft of a motor vehicle, 1 theft from a motor vehicle and 1 vehicle interference. Suspects are being seen to use an electronic device to scan the key and cars electronic signal to gain entry to the vehicle. Investigations continue with the help of the Victims and any witnesses. We will continue to work with residents where information is provided to

concentrate our patrols in targeted areas.

Carrying a knife or gun is illegal. Carrying a knife or gun increases your risk of being injured. It also increases the risk of the people around you being injured, and can cause great distress

and upset to your family.

Catalytic converter We successfully Marked 20 cars on the 6th of October 2023 at Tesco's, Purley. Catalytic converters are devices fitted to a vehicles exhausts to reduce the amount of dangerous gases emitted. These are frequently targeted by thieves because it contains valuable metals that can be removed.




