### **PRIORITIES**

VIOLENCE AGAINST THE PERSON: The Ward has seen low levels of reports regarding Violence against the person cases reported in December (6 Common Assault and 2 ABH) two of these incidents were road rage, 4 domestic incident and 1 incident on the public bus. The team will continue to increase visibility with patrols and reassurance visits where possible.

**Drugs**: We had no reports of drug offences in the month of December. The team have worked together to patrol in all wards including Old Coulsdon, Coulsdon Town, Kenley, Purley and Woodcote as part of consistent patrol tasking .We will continue to work with residents where information is provided to concentrate our visible patrols both on foot and mobile in a more needed areas.

**Motor Vehicle**: We had 3 vehicle crimes reported in the month of December (1 criminal damage and 1 theft of and 1 theft from motor vehicle) suspect had gained entry to victim's house while victim was asleep, various items were stolen including bank cards, keys, car and power tools. We continue to work with residents where information is provided to concentrate our patrols in targeted areas.

#### **HOW TO KEEP YOUR VEHCLE SAFE**

Check for cloning before owning your car

Lock your vehicle

Keep the keys safe

Be aware of carjacker

Fit in good in-car security locks

Put the keys in a screened or signal-blocking pouch, such as a Faraday Bag
