PRIORITIES

VIOLENCE AGAINST THE PERSON : We had a slight increase of violence against the person reported in the month of September 2024 (5 Common Assault, 3 ABH and 1 Attempted GBH) some of these incidents are domestics, neighbours and 1 school incidents. We will continue to increase our visibility patrols and reassurance visits where possible.

Burglary: We have 0 burglary reported to Safer Neighbourhood Team in the Month of September. We will continue to distribute leaflets and carry out reassurance visits where possible.

ASB: We had 1 ASB report in September (**1 ASB Nuisance in relation to erratic driving of a motor vehicle**) We will continue to increase our reassurance visits to give crime prevention advice where possible as well as mobile and foot patrols where possible .

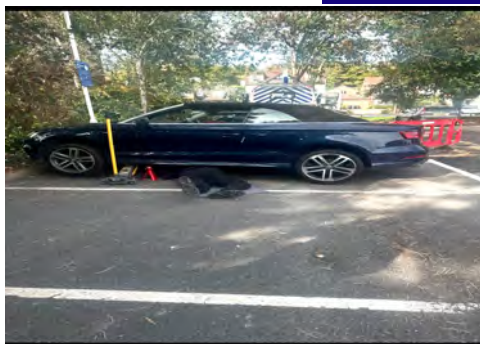
Report antisocial behaviour

Crime prevention Advice: Burglary

It's vital to leave your home secure whenever you leave it. Getting into an 'exit routine' can help ensure that you don't forget obvious,

important things, like not leaving your valuables near windows, or no lights on if it will be dark before you get home

Try to get into the habit of following your own course of action when you lock up your home. This will ensure that you don't forget anything

close and lock all your doors and windows, even if you're only going out for a few minutes

double-lock any door

make sure that any valuables are out of sight

keep handbags away from the letterbox or cat flap and hide all keys including car keys,
